

The Pleasantview Sculpture Garden



September has been a special "Sculptural" month for the Pleasantview third graders. Nasser Pirasteh, a local sculptor, spent a two week residency with the students. The residency began with a sculpture garden of the artist's work that was set up in the Media Center for everyone in the school to experience. The third grade class also visited a gallery of sculpture and took a field trip to the artist's studio. After seeing many examples of sculpture, the students began building their own

models from sketches they had drawn. Five models were selected for enlargement. The height of each sculpture was equal to the height of the student who designed the sketch. All of the sculptures are on display within the school.
